<b>THOSE WHO DO NOT HAVE SOCIAL SECURITY</b>	With the fee receipt to be given after the payment to the cashier of our faculty
<b>PRIVATE BANKS</b>	With the fee receipt to be given after the payment to the cashier of our faculty
<b>STATE BANKS</b>	They come with their referrals from their institutions and ID cards.
<b>CRIMINAL CASES</b>	Prosecution and police documents (Forensic Case Notification Form, Identity Card Photocopy, Record of Statement)
<b>APPLICATION AS PART OF HEALTH TOURISM</b>	It is invoiced within the prices determined by the Ministry of Health and payment is received from the patient.
<b>FOREIGN INSURED</b>	With "YUPASS" No

<b>FOREIGN STUDENTS</b>	With their numbers starting with "YU"
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NOTE: Our patients **aged 14 and under** will apply to the **-Pedodontics (Child First Examination)** department, and our patients aged 15 and over will apply to the **Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology (First Examination) department**. **Patients under 18 years of age must come with their parents for examination and treatment.**

**WITHOUT FIRST APPLICATION, PATIENTS' APPLICATIONS TO OUR OTHER DEPARTMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED\*\*\***

Patients who come to our Faculty for the first time can register at the Patient Reception on the ground floor with the documents mentioned above and have their first examination in the Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology Department or in the Paediatric First Examination Department on the same floor with the sequence numbers given to them. Our patients whose examination has been completed by the relevant doctor can make their appointments and continue their treatment by applying to the necessary clinics after their examination information has been recorded in the system.

For treatment items that are not included in the notices regularly published by the SSI, our patients can continue their treatment by opening a special procedure item.

Patients who re-apply to our Faculty should bring

- ✓ their identity documents and
- ✓ the patient card issued by our Faculty.
- ✓ They should have their registration opened at the clinic secretariat when they come to the clinic at the appointment time.
- ✓ Patients with infectious diseases such as hepatitis should schedule their appointment for the last appointment time of the day.
