General Information

Founded in 1992 with the opening of Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University, Music Education Department started education-teaching in Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University Faculty of Education in 1995. Music Education Science Second Cycle Degree without Thesis Master's Degree Program was opened in 2015-2016 academic year.

There are 1 professor, 2 associate professors, 5 doctoral lecturers, 2 lecturers and 1 research assistant in the education and training staff.

Graduates who have successfully completed the program are awarded a non-thesis master's degree in Music Teaching.

Aims and Goals

Aims:

The aim of our Science Department is to enable music teachers who have successfully completed undergraduate education to be able to make education in a more effective framework. Level-Turkey Higher Education Qualifications Framework (THEQF) and Degrees

Students who have successfully completed the program will be given a MASTER OF EDUCATION MASTER'S DEGREE SECONDARY EDUCATION GRADUATE DEGREE.

The master program without thesis in Music Teaching is a program consisting of at least ten semesters and a maximum of three semesters consisting of term project lessons provided that it is not less than 30 credits and 60 ECTS credits.

The program, Bologna process "in higher education EQF Top Frame" as defined in "Second Level (Second Cycle)" and "Turkey Higher Education Qualifications Framework (THEQF)" as defined in the "Level 7" is set for the adequacy ECTS credit conditions and level qualifications; at the same time, the "European Level of Lifelong Learning Qualifications Framework ".

Admission Requirements

For the candidates who will apply for this program, the conditions of admission to Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University Graduate Education-Examination and Examination Regulations shall apply. Programa Undergraduate graduation grade average is evaluated and accepted as a student.

Program Profile

Examination Regulations, Assessment and Grading System

The methods used to measure whether program learning outcomes are predicted during the Master's program without Music Education are listed below.

- Midterm
- Final exam
- Compensation Exam
- Homework Evaluation

Exams:

The success of the students in achieving the expected learning outcomes of each course unit included in the curriculum of the Music Education Non-Thesis Master's program is measured by in-term activities and final exams at the end of each semester.

Programs are encouraged to identify more assessment methods in the inter-period activities, depending on the need to measure the success of the program and course-level outcomes in order to achieve educational goals and objectives. The nature and number of the evaluation methods used for each course are given under the heading "Assessment and Evaluation" in the course description sections together with contributions to the term end grade. These regulations are announced at the beginning of each semester, and part of course descriptions are posted on the website.

Midterm and final exams are held on the date, place and time determined and announced by the university. It is given by the lecturers taking into consideration that the students are provided with the attendance condition based on the results of the students' term-end notes, mid-term exam, homework evaluation, quizzes, final exam and other evaluation results.

At the end of the semester, the contribution of the semester activities can be maximum 40% and the contribution of the final exam is at least 40% and at most 60% for the courses in all graduate programs determined by the Regulation.

Evaluation:

A student's success is assessed by the instructor for each assessment (in-term studies and final) defined for each course. The evaluation is based on a total score of 100 and is converted into a letter grade using the relative evaluation methodology determined by the Senate, taking into consideration the standard deviation and grade average of the grade at the end of the semester.

Graduation Requirements

A student must meet the following conditions in order to be able to graduate from the Masters in Music Teaching Program without thesis:

• To complete 120 ECTS credits by taking a passing grade,

• Successfully complete the term project, which is presented in the form of a scientific research report and prepared in accordance with the relevant institute dissertation writing guide, in a scientific subject investigated and / or examined during the master's education without thesis.
