Masters with Thesis

- Thesis Master's program consists of minimum seven courses; a seminar course and a thesis study provided that it is not less than a total of twenty one credits.
- In order to complete the program, the student must complete at least 30 ECTS credits in each semester and in total 120 ECTS (excluding special subject courses). The prepared thesis in the field must be defended and found successful by the jury.
- In graduate programs, the success grade of a course is the sum of 40% of the midterm grade average and 60% of the final / makeup In order for the student to be successful, this grade must be at least 75 points over 100 points in the graduate programs with thesis.
- Seminar course, special topics and thesis study are not credited and are evaluated as successful or unsuccessful.
- Each semester the student must take one compulsory course (excluding the Scientific Research Techniques and Publication Ethics course) of the related semester selected from the compulsory course package.
- Scientific Research Techniques and Publishing Ethic Course along with seminar should be taken in the specified semester plan.
- Students must register to special topics course from the semester following the appointment of the advisor.
- From the semester following the appointment of the advisor, the thesis topic should be proposed to the institute by the decision of the department until the end of the second semester at the latest.
- If the student's Thesis Proposal is accepted by the institute board (EYK), the student is considered to be successful in the Thesis Study (Thesis Proposal) and must register for the thesis study from the semester following the success of the student.
- The student should register to thesis study each semester beginning from the semester an advisor is appointed.
