

## GRADE EVALUATION

### Success grade

-The success grade of a course in graduate programs is the sum of 40% of the midterm grade average and 60% of the general /make-up exam and in order for the student to be deemed successful, this grade must be at least 75/100 in masters with thesis programs and at least 80/100 in doctoral programs.

-The exam grades of graduate courses are calculated out of 100. However, when requested, the student's educational background document can also be arranged according to the alphabetic or quadruple coefficient system, taking into account the following equivalence table:

- In order to be deemed successful, graduate students must have at least CB and doctoral students must have at least BB grade from a course.

-When preparing a document according to the letter system, a student who does not have the right to take the general/make-up exams because the student does not fulfil the attendance and / or performance requirements is considered unsuccessful by assigning an NA grade to him.

- A student who gets seminar, thesis work, special topics and specialization courses is evaluated as successful or unsuccessful.

- A student has to take and become successful in the courses he failed during the term. In case the failed course is taken again, the attendance condition is not required. In case of failure due to absenteeism, the attendance condition is required. However, instead of the elective course the student failed, s/he can take another course in the related period, with the approval of the advisor. Absenteeism criterion is also required for the course taken instead of the failed one. In case of failure in the courses requiring application/performance, the student is required to continue the course even if he has fulfilled the attendance requirement.

-- Requirements for success in examinations, grades, courses, and absenteeism issues related to the scientific preparatory program are carried out in line with the legislative provisions for the undergraduate level courses, while the registration deletion, other issues and the graduate level courses taken in the scientific preparatory program are evaluated according to the provisions of the Graduate Education Regulations.

### Academic Average

The academic average is the numerical value obtained from each course multiplied by the credit of that course and the sum of the obtained results is divided by the sum of the credits of the courses. The result is indicated by two digits after the third digit is rounded.
