

Masters with Thesis

- Thesis Master's program consists of minimum seven courses; a seminar course and a thesis study provided that it is not less than a total of twenty one credits.
- In order to complete the program, the student must complete at least 30 ECTS credits in each semester and in total 120 ECTS (excluding special subject courses). The prepared thesis in the field must be defended and found successful by the jury
- Students who have registered before the 2024-2025 Academic Year Fall Semester and failed the compulsory courses they had previously chosen from the compulsory course package will be able to complete the ECTS credits they need to take in one semester by taking the same or a different course from the elective course package instead of the course they failed,
- Students having registered in the Spring Semester of the 2023-2024 Academic Year will not take compulsory courses except the "Scientific Research Techniques and Publication Ethics" course in the Fall Semester of the 2024-2025 Academic Year,
- Seminar course, special topics and thesis study are not credited and are evaluated as successful or unsuccessful.
- Scientific Research Techniques and Publishing Ethic Course along with seminar should be taken in the specified semester plan.
- Students must register to special topics course from the semester following the appointment of the advisor.
- From the semester following the appointment of the advisor, the thesis topic should be proposed to the institute by the decision of the department until the end of the second semester at the latest.
- If the student's Thesis Proposal is accepted by the institute board (EYK), the student is considered to be successful in the Thesis Study (Thesis Proposal) and must register for the thesis study from the semester following the success of the student.
- The student should register to thesis study each semester beginning from the semester an advisor is appointed.
