Pursuant to Article 8/(2)(k) of the “Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University Graduate Education, Training and Examination Regulation” and Articles 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the “Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University Directive on Admission of International Students to Graduate Programs,” international students will be admitted to the graduate programs of the departments listed below for the **Spring Semester of the 2025–2026 Academic Year** by the Institute of Health Sciences of our University.

According to the Directive on Admission of International Students to Graduate Programs of Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University;

Documents Required from Candidates Applying to Master's Programs with Thesis:

1. For master's programs: an original or certified copy of the bachelor's diploma or graduation certificate approved by the foreign mission and its certified Turkish translation.
2. For PhD/Proficiency in Art programs:
 - Candidates applying with a bachelor's degree must submit their bachelor's diploma,
 - Candidates applying with a master's degree must submit their master's diploma or graduation certificate, both approved by the foreign mission and accompanied by a certified Turkish translation.
3. A certified copy of the transcript and its certified Turkish translation. For PhD/Proficiency in Art programs, a document proving foreign language proficiency is required. Candidates who do not have a foreign language score at the time of application must meet the foreign language requirement before taking the proficiency exam of the PhD/Proficiency in Art program.
4. Students registered in PhD/Proficiency in Art programs who wish to take the proficiency exam must have obtained at least **55 points** from central foreign language exams conducted by YÖK or ÖSYM, or an equivalent score from internationally recognized foreign language exams accepted by YÖK. Candidates who have completed their undergraduate or graduate education in a foreign language deemed appropriate by the department may be exempted from the foreign language requirement upon documentation, with the decision of the department board and approval of the Institute Administrative Board (IAB).

Application Requirements for Master's Programs with Thesis:

1. Graduates of undergraduate or graduate programs of universities who are:
 - a) Foreign nationals who later acquired Turkish citizenship or who hold dual citizenship in this status,
 - b) Turkish citizens who completed their entire undergraduate education in a foreign country,
 - c) Foreign nationals, may apply as international students.
2. The institutions from which the candidates have graduated must be recognized by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). Even if students graduate from institutions not recognized by YÖK and complete registration, their affiliation with the relevant Institute will be terminated.

Evaluation of Applications for Master's Programs with Thesis:

1. Application files of candidates applying to graduate programs are evaluated by the relevant department board. Evaluation results, along with their justifications, are submitted to the institutes by department board decision. Admission of candidates deemed eligible becomes final upon approval of the Institute Administrative Board (IAB).
2. Candidates applying to the relevant institute based on bilateral agreements to which the University is a party, as well as candidates applying directly to the department or a faculty member, may be admitted to graduate programs outside the quota with the decision of the department board and approval of the IAB. Accepted candidates must complete their final registration and course registration within the dates announced on the institute's website in the following semester.
3. For candidates whose graduation GPA is based on a 4-point system, the 100-point system equivalent will be determined according to YÖK's grade conversion table.
4. For candidates enrolling in programs taught in Turkish: except for those who hold a Turkish C1 certificate from TÖMER, NÖHÜTÖMER, or the Yunus Emre Institute, or who graduated from a higher education institution in Türkiye, Turkish proficiency will be evaluated by NÖHÜTÖMER. Candidates with insufficient Turkish proficiency will be granted leave for two semesters to learn Turkish. At the end of this period, candidates who obtain a C1 level Turkish Proficiency Certificate submit their documents to the Institute at the beginning of the relevant semester and begin their studies. Candidates who fail to submit a C1 certificate or fail the Turkish proficiency exam administered by NÖHÜTÖMER are granted an additional two semesters. If Turkish proficiency is still deemed insufficient at the end of the additional period, the student's enrollment with the relevant Institute will be terminated.
5. Students enrolling in graduate programs taught in a foreign language are subject to a compulsory foreign language preparatory program. The provisions of the Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University School of Foreign Languages Preparatory Program Education and Examination Regulation apply.
6. Applications of candidates who do not meet the application requirements will not be evaluated.

Announcement of Results and Final Registration:

1. Application results will be announced on the Institute's website.
2. Candidates who earn the right to register will be sent an acceptance letter by the Institute.
3. Registrations will be carried out by the Institute Student Affairs Unit on the dates announced on the Institute's website.
4. Unless exempted from tuition fees through bilateral agreements, students are required to pay the tuition fee determined by the University Administrative Board within the framework of the Council of Ministers' Decision.

Documents Required for Final Registration:

1. Final registration form,
2. Original diploma or graduation certificate and its certified Turkish translation by sworn translators,
3. Original transcript and its certified Turkish translation by sworn translators,
4. Certified copy of passport,
5. Six photographs taken within the last six months,
6. General Health Insurance (GHI) document obtained from the Social Security Institution,
7. Proof of payment of the tuition fee (Pursuant to the decision of the University Administrative Board dated **23/07/2025** and numbered **2025/207**, the tuition fee is **6,651 TL**).

- ❖ Students who earn the right to final registration but submit incomplete documents will not be registered.
- ❖ Students who fail to obtain a residence permit for educational purposes from the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management using their student certificate after final registration will have their enrollment cancelled.
