In accordance with Article 8/(2)(k) of the “Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University Postgraduate Education and Examination Regulation” and Articles 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the “Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University International Student Admission to Postgraduate Programs Directive”, international students will be admitted to the Master's and Doctoral Programs of the Departments listed below in the Fall Semester of the 2026-2027 Academic Year by our University's Institute of Health Sciences.

Documents Required from Candidates Applying to Thesis-Based Master's Programs:

1. For master's programs, a certified copy of the bachelor's degree or graduation certificate from the foreign representation and its certified Turkish translation.
2. For doctoral/arts proficiency programs, candidates applying to doctoral programs with a bachelor's degree must submit a certified copy of their bachelor's degree diploma or graduation certificate from the foreign representation and a certified Turkish translation; candidates applying with a master's degree must submit a certified copy of their master's degree diploma or graduation certificate from the foreign representation and a certified Turkish translation.
3. Certified copy of the transcript and its certified Turkish translation.

4. Document demonstrating foreign language proficiency for doctoral/arts proficiency programs. (Candidates who do not have a foreign language score for application to doctoral/arts proficiency programs must fulfill the foreign language requirement before taking the proficiency exam for the doctoral/arts proficiency programs.)

5. Students enrolled in doctoral/artistic proficiency programs who wish to take the proficiency exam must have obtained a minimum score of 55 on a central foreign language exam administered by YÖK or ÖSYM, or an equivalent score on an international foreign language exam accepted by YÖK. (Candidates who have completed their undergraduate or graduate studies in a foreign language deemed appropriate by the department/field of study may be exempted from the foreign language requirement upon the decision of the department/field board and the approval of the Executive Board, provided they can document this.)

Application Requirements for Thesis-Based Master's Programs:

(1) Graduates of undergraduate or graduate programs from universities;

a) Individuals who, while being citizens of a foreign country, acquired Turkish citizenship or hold dual citizenship,

b) Turkish citizens who have completed their entire undergraduate education in a foreign country,

c) Those who are citizens of a foreign country can apply as international students.

(2) Candidates must have graduated from institutions recognized by the Council of Higher Education (YÖK). Students who have graduated from institutions not recognized by YÖK will be dismissed from the relevant Institute even if they have registered.

Evaluation of Applications for Thesis-Based Master's Programs:

(1) Applications for graduate programs are evaluated by the departmental board of the relevant program, and the evaluation results, along with the reasons, are sent to the institutes with the decision of the departmental board. The acceptance of candidates deemed suitable into graduate programs is finalized with the approval of the Executive Board.

(2) Candidates applying to the relevant institute based on bilateral agreements to which the university is a party, as well as candidates applying directly to the department/relevant department faculty member, may be accepted as graduate students outside the quota, subject to the decision of the department board and the approval of the Executive Board. Candidates whose applications are accepted must complete their final registration and course registration procedures on the dates announced on the institute's website in the following semester.

(3) For candidates whose graduation grade point average is calculated using the four-point system, the YÖK (Council of Higher Education) grade conversion table is used to determine the equivalent grade point averages in the hundred-point system.

(4) For candidates enrolled in programs where the language of instruction is Turkish, Turkish language proficiency is assessed by NÖHÜTÖMER, with the exception of those who have obtained a C1 level Turkish language certificate from TÖMER, NÖHÜTÖMER, or the Yunus Emre Institute, or those who have graduated from a higher education institution in Turkey. Candidates with insufficient Turkish language proficiency are granted a two-semester leave of absence to learn Turkish. At the end of this period, those who obtain a C1 level Turkish language proficiency certificate submit their certificates to the Institute at the beginning of the relevant semester and begin their studies. Students who fail to submit a C1 level Turkish language proficiency certificate or fail the Turkish language proficiency exam administered by NÖHÜTÖMER at the end of the granted leave of absence are given an additional two

semesters. Students whose Turkish language proficiency is still deemed insufficient at the end of the additional period will be dismissed from the Institute.

(5) Students enrolled in postgraduate programs taught in a foreign language are required to complete a compulsory foreign language preparatory program. The regulations of the Niğde Ömer Halisdemir University School of Foreign Languages Preparatory Program Education, Teaching and Examination are applicable to this compulsory preparatory program.

(6) Applications from candidates who do not meet the application requirements will not be considered.

Announcement of Results and Final Registration:

- 1- Application results will be announced on the Institute's website.
- 2- Candidates who are accepted will receive an acceptance letter from the Institute.
- 3- Registrations will be handled by the Institute's Student Affairs Unit on the dates announced on the Institute's website.
- 4- Unless the student is exempt from tuition fees through bilateral agreements, they are obligated to pay the tuition fee determined by the University Board of Directors within the framework of the Council of Ministers' Decision.

Documents Required for Final Registration:

- 1) Final registration form,
- 2) Original diploma or graduation certificate along with a certified copy of its translation into Turkish by sworn translators,
- 3) Original transcript along with a certified copy of its translation into Turkish by sworn translators,
- 4) Certified copy of passport,
- 5) One photograph taken within the last six months,
- * 6) Proof of payment of tuition fee, (According to the decision of our University's Board of Directors dated 23/07/2025 and numbered 2025/207, the tuition fee is 6,651 TL.)

* The tuition fee, determined by the University's Board of Directors' decision dated 23/07/2025 and numbered 2025/207, is 6,651 TL **and will be updated for the 2026-2027 academic year.**

- ❖ Students who have been accepted for final registration will not be able to register if they have incomplete required documents.
- ❖ Students who fail to obtain a residence permit for educational purposes from the Provincial Directorate of Migration Management with their student certificate after final registration will have their registration cancelled.
