- 1. S/he will be able to present the knowledge of basic concepts of sociology
- 2. S/he will be able to associate basic concepts of sociology with concrete cases
- 3. S/he will be able to have more detailed information about sub-disciplines of sociology
- 4. S/he will be able to use the statistical techniques of sociology effectively
- 5. S/he will be able to abstract concrete social events
- 6. S/he will be able to create appropriate theoretical structure in the sociological analysis of problems or issues
- 7. S/he will be able to have knowledge and skills for reaching sociological data, and other scientific sources
- 8. S/he will be able to gain skills for preparing and implementing scientific research projects
- 9. S/he will be able to learn which research methods and implementation techniques should be applied to a scientific research question
- 10. S/he will be able to support sociological issues with practical application (such as; village, museum, prison visits )
- 11. S/he will be able to view social events from different angles
- 12. S/he will be able to apply critical thinking to everyday events
