Study in Brașov, Romania!

Brașov, a city with an attested history of over 700 years, lies at the foot of Mount Tâmpa. It offers an ideal blend between the natural landscape and the charming medieval architecture. The newest areas of the constantly expanding city are both residential and industrial as well as leisure spaces.

Not far from the city, only 12 kilometers away, is the largest ski resort of Romania, Poiana Brașov and, at about 30 kilometers away is the Bran Castle, commonly associated with the legend of Dracula. In the towns around the city of Brașov, there are about 10 fortified churches, two of which, Prejmer and Viscri, are classified as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. All this, along with the friendliness of the people living here, have turned Brașov into one of the country's main tourist cities.
