- Check the exam duration and make sure that you have saved and sent your answers on the system.
- You have only 1 (one) right to have the exam on MERGEN system.
- Your exam will consist of 40 questions and the duration will be 80 minutes. You will be given 5 options for each question.
- Considering the technical problems that may be experienced, do not leave the exam to the last days and hours.
- You can contact responsible lecturer for the problems about your exam. During the exam, your teachers will be accessible through different communication means.
- Do not forget that it is a crime to take any action on social media or other platforms which may violate the security of exams and / or copyright of the questions and this will result in an enquiry / investigation against you.
